## RETREAT FOCUS

This three-day retreat offers participants a time to be refreshed, rejuvenated, and spiritually renewed by means of a focused encounter with our triune God, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Spiritual formation practices serve as pathways for coming to know God more intimately and to experience his presence in deeper ways. Participants have the opportunity to receive healing and strengthening in their soul that provides inspiration for ongoing service in the ministry of Jesus Christ.

The time-frame for the retreat is a full 70 hours, normally beginning on a Thursday evening at 5:30 pm for dinner with fellow participants, spiritual directors and staff, and ending on Sunday afternoon at 4:00 pm. Since this activity is a very focused time of intentionally seeking the presence of the Lord in community, participants must be present and remain on campus for the entire period of time.

Formal registration is required and online pre-retreat reading materials are available in order to help prepare for this unique and spiritually formative experience. The retreat is also offered for academic credit through Grace Communion Seminary ([www.gcs.edu](http://www.gcs.edu)).



# THE TRIUNE GOD

This spiritually-focused and restful retreat experience provides participants with a time for “unplugging” from life and ministry responsibilities. As participants get in touch with their own soul and spirit, as well as where they are in relationship to the God who sends them into the world to carry out the ministry of Christ to the Father *through* the power of the Spirit, they experience spiritual renewal and are prepared for more effective ministry service.

## GOD THE FATHER

The primary focus for the first retreat day is the overwhelming love of God the Father for us as his children. Participants are positioned to see where they are in their personal spiritual journey with God as their Father.

## GOD THE SON

The second day of the retreat presents an opportunity for participants to focus on their relationship with Jesus the Son who invites them to intimate communion through his loving embrace and call to co-participate in his ministry.

## GOD THE HOLY SPIRIT
